VII Youth championship in Russian and international draughts 'Hameleons - 2024'

Regulations

I. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1.1. The aim of the competition is to develop draughts sports in European countries, motivate children and youth to take part in the process of development of draughts and improve their own skill.
- 1.2. To develop Russian and international draughts amongst children and youth in Europe.
- 1.3. To organize qualitative children's and youth draughts tournaments, promote their creative development, develop communicative skills, talents.

II. TIME AND PLACE

- 2.1. The competition is held from June 12, 2024, to December 21, 2024.
- 2.2. The stages of the competition take place in in Budapest (Hungary), Bratislava (Slovakia) and Rome (Italy) – see table 1.

III. ORGANIZATION AND PLACEMENT

- 3.1. The competition is organized by 'Diagonale' society and Vsevolod Teterin.
- 3.2. Official tournament page: <https://www.albatross.land/>.
- 3.3. Director of the tournament – Vsevolod Teterin.

IV. PARTICIPANTS

- 4.1. Young men and women born in 2006 and younger (up to and including 2011) from Latvia, Estonia, Hungary, Moldova, the Czech Republic and other countries can take part in the competition.
- 4.2. Each participant of the competition is personally responsible for his health or his parents or accompanying persons are responsible for his health.

V. COMPETITION PROGRAM AND RULES

- 5.1. The competition at each stage is held according to the rules of FMJD and IDF, and to the principles of Swiss system in 7 rounds. Time control: 10 min. + 3 sec. per move (for each micro-match game) in Russian draughts; 15 min. + 3 sec. per move for one game in international draughts.
- 5.2. In Russian draughts tournament is held with the draw of the first white move.
- 5.3. The competition is held using Draughts Arbiter program. For a win a player gets 2 points, for a draw – 1 point, for a loss – 0 points.
- 5.4. The winner is the participant who scored the most points.
- 5.5. Determination of places at each stage in case of equal total score:
 - 5.5.1. Solkoff system (S-1, S-2);
 - 5.5.2. number of wins;
 - 5.5.3. result of the direct encounter;
 - 5.5.4. player's rating.
- 5.6. After each stage participants are assigned points (tournament points + points according to the table), the rating is calculated and entered into the general table.

- 5.7. In case of equality of points, places are determined according to the following criteria:
 - 5.7.1. points are collected in fewer stages;
 - 5.7.2. the sum of places after all played stages;
 - 5.7.3. player's rating.
- 5.8. The best players are determined by the results of the overall standings of the 'Albatross' and 'Hameleons' tournaments.

VI. AWARDS

- 6.1. The participants who took the first three places are awarded diplomas, medals and prizes at each stage of the competition:
 - 1st place – gift card 50 EUR;
 - 2nd place – gift card 30 EUR;
 - 3rd place – gift card 20 EUR.
- 6.2. At the end of the year the participants who took the first three places in the overall standings are awarded prizes:
 - 1st place – special prize 'Hameleons' + free annual participation in tournaments 'Hameleons' + prize money 150,00 EUR (one hundred and fifty);
 - 2nd place – prize money 50 EUR;
 - 3rd place – prize money 30 EUR;
- 6.3. At the end of the year the best players in the following categories are determined:
 - 6.3.1. Season's best player;
 - 6.3.2. Best player of the 'Diagonale' system's tournaments;

- 6.3.3. Best young woman of the 'Diagonale' system's tournaments;
- 6.3.4. The most respectable player of the 'Diagonale' system's tournaments;
- 6.3.5. 'Season's breakout' – the most successful player of the 'Diagonale' system's tournaments;
- 6.3.6. The most successful coach and club of the season.

VII. COMPETITION EXPENSES AND PARTICIPATION FEES

7.1. Competition organisational expenses are covered by the players:

7.3. Members of the 'Albatross-350' club pay a ½ part of the tournament fee.

7.4. For members of the 'Hameleons-500' club participation is free.

7.5. All expenses related to participation are the responsibility of sending organizations.

VIII. APPLICATIONS AND LEGAL ISSUES

8.1. Applications for participation are submitted by organizations or coaches.

8.2. Participation in the competition must be confirmed **30 days before the specified date of the stage** by registering in the DAMBA electronic database and receiving confirmation from the organizers of the tournament. For all questions please write timely by e-mail: diagonale@albatross.land. In the application it is necessary to specify the name, surname, year of birth of the participant and the name of the region.

8.3. If less than 40 players participate in the competition, then a general tournament 'Albatross & Chameleon' is held and cash prizes are awarded only to the first three in the overall standings.

8.4. The organizers of the tournament ensure the protection of personal data of individuals in accordance with the Legislative Acts of EU.

8.5. The organizers of the tournament provide video broadcasts from each stage of the competition.

8.6. Club may be refused an application, according to Regulation of the European Parliament of April 27, 2016 (ES) 2016/679 'On the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free

movement of such data', if a minor participant of the competition or his official representatives, including guardians, do not agree with the processing of the participant's personal results, as well as photographing and videotaping for the purpose of publishing information in the mass media. Also an application may be refused in case of violation by a participant of ethical, sports and other norms of behavior at sports competitions of 'Diagonale' society system, as a result of which the course of competitions or other events of 'Diagonale' society is disrupted.

8.7. The participants of the tournament are familiar with and agree with the Legal and Sports Regulations of 'Diagonale' society, on the basis of which any issues arising at the competition are considered.
